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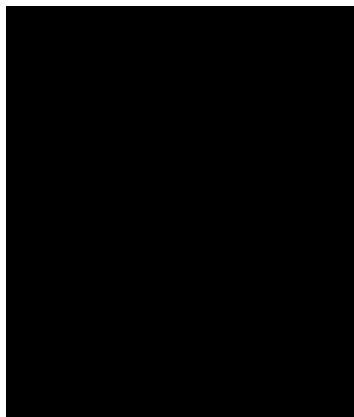

Itinerary August 06-22, 2010

Aug 06 - Arrive Lima Transfer to hotel, Overnight Lima hotel.

Aug 07 - Lima to Arequipa (B) Fly from Lima to Arequipa. Transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is free to relax and explore Arequipa, Peru's second largest city yet it maintains a laid back atmosphere and a traditional colonial style as it lies in the shadow of El Misti volcano. Overnight hotel Arequipa

Aug 08 - Arequipa to Colca Canyon (B) Travel for approximately 3 ½ hours through high plains flanked by extensive Inca and pre-Inca terracing en route to Colca Canyon. We enjoy spectacular views of volcanoes, agricultural terraces and wild alpaca and vicuña herds. Colca canyon is also home to the great condors of Peru and reported to be the deepest canyon in the world. Overnight hotel Coca.

Aug 09 - Coca Canyon- Arequipa-Cusco (B) Today we will journey back to Arequipa. We will have some free time to relax and explore before boarding our overnight bus to Cusco.

August 10- Cusco (B) Arrive early morning check into hotel. Rest of day will be free to explore the sights and sounds of my favorite city. Do some shopping or join me in the Afternoon for a walking tour. Overnight hotel Cusco

Aug 11-14- Chitapampa Community Volunteer- Work (B, L) Each morning we will travel to the rural community of Chitapampa outside of Cusco. We will be painting the school, building mud bricks and completing several other projects for the community. Afternoon return to Cusco. Overnight hotel Cusco.

Aug 15 - Chitapampa-(B) Today we will travel to Chitapampa one last time to say goodbye and enjoy the local Virgin of the Asunta festival. If we are lucky, enjoy some traditionally cooked cuy and some cheecha. Overnight hotel Cusco.

Aug 16 - Sacred Valley / Ollantaytambo - (B) Today we will depart early with our guide and journey through the Sacred Valley. Including the Pisac Terraces and the picturesque town and Inca ruins of Ollantaytambo. Overnight Ollantaytambo Hotel.

Aug 17-20 Inca Trail to Machu Picchu - (3 Breakfast, 3 Lunches, 3 Dinners) Begin your once in a lifetime journey on the ancient trail of the Incas with a morning trip to km 82, where our hike starts. Local porters and guides ensure that the trip is worry-free. Fascinating ruins and spectacular mountain scenery fill every day of the hike. On our final day, we climb the steps to Intipunku, the 'Sun Gate', and enjoy your first view of Machu Picchu before our tour of the famous Inca ruin. Afternoon we begin our journey back to Cuzco. Overnight Cusco Hotel.

Aug 21- Cusco/ Lima-(B) Today we will say goodbye to Cusco and our guide. Flight to Lima, city tour and some free time before our late night or early morning flight home
