itinerary

March 12 – 19, 2010:

March 12, 2010 Today we will Depart Toronto for Lima Peru. Tonight we will spend the night at the hotel Melodia in Lima; the evening is ours to rest. (Meals are not included on this day)

March 13, 2010 – B, L, D This morning we will depart early for our transfer to the airport and fly from Lima to Iquitos. Upon arriving in Iquitos we will travel by speedboat upriver for two hours on the Amazon River, then two hours upriver on a tributary, called the Tahuayo River, to Amazonia's lodge. The rest of the day will be free to choose from one of their many excursions; swimming with pink dolphins, flying through the treetops on a canopy zip line, visiting native villages or having a session with a native shaman and much more.

March 14, 2010- B, L, D Today we start our volunteering by assisting with a local school in Chino Village. Working with the community on community projects is known as a minga & will involve socialization with the community and a minga fiesta with the community Sunday night.

March 15, 2010- B, L, D Today we will share a nutritional breakfast with the local children at the school. This school will host a ceremony celebration for us. This afternoon we will have the honor of visiting local homes in the community and participating in some local activities.

March 16, 2010- B, L, D We will travel to the Amazonia's research center lodge, La Cia to continue with our volunteering. We will have the opportunity to assist in recording sightings of animals, help in the collection of data for conservation management, and habituate wild groups of monkeys for researchers to study.

March 17, 2010- B, L, D We will continue with the activities at the La Cia research lodge this morning and then return to the main lodge in the afternoon. The rest of the day will be free to choose from the many excursions offered at the lodge. Tonight we will enjoy a farewell fiesta

March 18, 2010 - B, L This morning we can choose from one of the many excursions offered. This afternoon we will take the boat transfer back to Iquitos where we will then be transferred to airport for your flight back to Lima. Tonight you will spend the night at the Carmel Hotel.

March 19, 2010 This Morning we will depart the hotel and take a tour to the San Francisco Church and catacombs; we will have lunch at a local restaurant and spend the afternoon at the Artisanal markets. We will stop for dinner before our transfer to the airport for our evening flight home. (Meals are not included on this day)
