01 October Toronto

Today you will start your journey to Italy, departing from Toronto on your international flight to Florence.

02 October Arrive Florence

Welcome to Tuscany! Today you will have a group arrival transfer included. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

03 October Florence

Today is a full free day to explore Florence, cradle of the Renaissance and birthplace of the Italian language. Check out the magnificent Duomo, the amazing markets and the many places to stop for a delicious latte!

04-05 October Lucca

Travel by train to magical Lucca. The afternoon and next day are free to get to know the piazzas, towers, and churches of this walled city, take a trip to Bagni di Lucca and relax at the thermal spa, or head to the nearby Garfagnana region for some hiking.

06 October Pisa/Siena

Depart Lucca for a short train ride to Pisa, and explore the world famous Leaning Tower. From Pisa take another train south to Siena.

07-08 October Siena One of Italy's best preserved medieval towns, Siena is one giant medieval museum, crammed with Gothic architecture and surrounding one of the world's most unique piazzas: Il Campo. Visit the quintessential medieval hilltop town of San Gimignano, with the next day free to explore on your own.

09 October Montepulciano

Travel by private van into the beautiful South Tuscan countryside to a nearby vineyard. Enjoy a tour (and of course a wine tasting!), followed by an optional lunch in a local restaurant. Spend the night in pretty Montepulciano.

10 October Florence

Return to the Tuscan capital for one last chance to enjoy the sights and a final farewell dinner with your group.
