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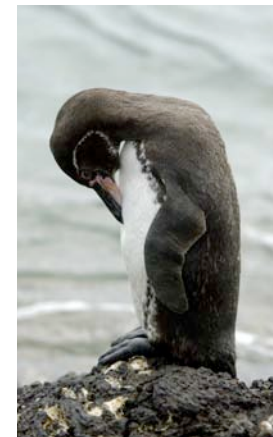

Galapagos Islands and Ecuador

April 26 to
May 6, 2010

There are few exotic destinations that spark the ecological imagination as the Galapagos Islands and Ecuador.



Our tour is a combination of some unique sightseeing coupled with an exploration of the Galapagos Archipelago. This remarkable tour includes visits to Charles Darwin Station, and a full day tour to Otavalo Market, and the Mindo Rainforest.



April 26 Toronto / Quito

Our group departs this morning from Toronto to Quito, Ecuador. At the airport you will be met and transferred to the Hotel Dann Carlton Quito for a 4 night stay.

April 27 Otavalo Market (B, L)

Visit the land of the Otavaleños and South America's most famous Indian fair. We may have an opportunity to stop at a local village and then we will continue through the dramatic mountain scenery to the textile market of Otavalo. Finally proceed to Peguche, home to artisans who do weaving in their homes. Enjoy lunch at one of the charming country inns in the area.

April 28 Quito (B, L)

Today we will enjoy a scenic six hour tour of Colonial Quito and Middle of the World Monument. Balance of the day is left open for individual exploration and discovery.

April 29 Mindo Rainforest (B, L)

Mindo is located on the west side of Quito in a deep valley surrounded by native Andean forest, represented by vegetation of three different life zones. We arrive at a local hosteria, where we will have the opportunity to enjoy an ecosystem that contains one of the largest varieties of birds and plant life in the world.

Mindo is a birdwatcher's paradise including numerous hummingbirds. There are many kinds of epiphytes, including orchids and bromeliads. Butterflies are plentiful. All this is located in the rainforest located at an altitude of 2,100m.
Overnight in Quito

April 30 Baltra – Cruise (B, L, D)

We are transferred to the airport for our flight to Baltra (lunch on board) where we will proceed to our expedition vessel, the M/V Santa Cruz for our three night / four day Galapagos Islands Cruise. All meals are included on board during our stay.

Cruise itinerary includes:

3 nights on expedition vessel

Kicker Rock & Cerro Brujo (San Cristobal)
Punta Suarez (Espanola/Hood Island)
Punta Cormorant (Florena Island)
Punta Espinoza (Fernandina Island)
Urbina Bay (Isabela Island)
Baltra (South Seymour) Island

Itinerary is subject to change due to local conditions

May 3 Finch Bay (B, L, D)

On arrival back in Baltra we will be met by a Finch Bay representative and proceed by bus and ferry to the Finch Bay Hotel. Today we tour the highlands of Santa Cruz to see free-range tortoises and also enjoy a guided visit to the Charles Darwin Research Station. The Charles Darwin Research Station conducts research focusing on terrestrial and marine conservation for the Galapagos. Lunch provided during excursion. Dinner and overnight at the Finch Bay Hotel.



May 04 Finch Bay (B, L, D)

This day is left open for personal or small group exploration. There are a large number of exciting opportunities and you may decide what best satisfies your interests.

May 05 Quito (B,L)

American breakfast included. Transfer to the airport and take a flight to Quito (lunch on board). Explore nearby Botanical Gardens, or Quito, on your own in the afternoon. Overnight at the Hotel Dann Carlton Quito.

May 06 Departure (B)

Coffee this morning before our early morning transfer and flight to return to Toronto.
