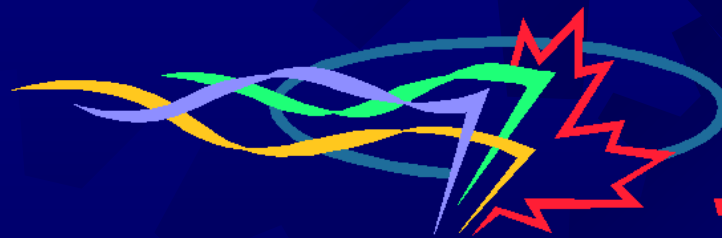

- ★ Full service hotel with pool, fitness centre, internet access(\$\$) and restaurants



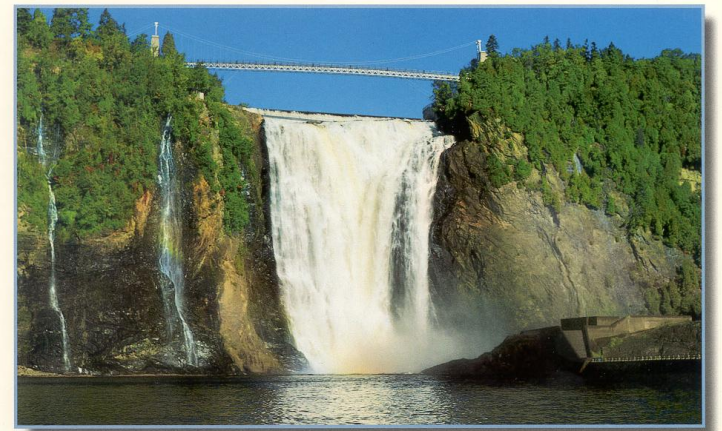

Airline Luggage

AIR CANADA CHECKED BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

Checked baggage

- ✦ ONE item of checked baggage is accepted per person. Second bag is at a cost and this will be covered by Skills/Goliger's Travel.
- ✦ Maximum size: 157 cm (62 in) per piece (length + width + height).
- ✦ Maximum weight: **23 kgs (50 lbs) per piece.**
- ✦ Please make every effort to pack conservatively.
- ✦ We recommend you list the items in your luggage/toolbox that may be considered 'dangerous' or suspicious.
- ✦ A carry on bag is also permitted but must be no more than 10kgs(22 lbs) and fit under your seat or in the overhead area. **No sharp objects (scissors, knives etc) may be carried in your carry on bag.**

Toolboxes

Skills Canada – Quebec City requests that all competitor toolboxes be dropped off at registration (We will have trucks to pick up the tool boxes and deliver to the competition site)

To ensure that toolboxes are correctly located in each event site for contest start time and security purposes, toolboxes must be securely packed in appropriate containers and must have labels clearly stating the following (your labels are in the Skills registration package):

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION/ATTENDANCE

Code of Conduct

2. I will, at all specified times, wear my official identification badge.
3. I will attend activities to which I am assigned and registered and will be on time.
4. I will adhere to the dress code at all times
5. I will spend each night in the accommodation to which I may be assigned.
6. I will respect all public and private property, including the accommodation to which I may be assigned.
7. I will refrain from the use of drugs (except prescribed medication).
